
GRADE 12 CAMP - 23 - 29 AUGUST, 2025

various stalls offering a wide range of items for sale. The event fostered a sense of community, allowing parents to connect with teachers and the administrators.










TEACHER'S DAY - 4th SEPTEMBER, 2025


PULLIKOLAM - 7thOCTOBER, 2025


